



We have a 50 acre site just outside Bodfari; mainly woodland but also permanent buildings, workshops, tree nursery, polytunnels, heritage orchard, wildflower meadow, medicinal herb garden, vineyard, arboretum and apiary.

We have a programme of courses, open to the public, in traditional crafts, environmental skills, countryside management, mindfulness and bushcraft. We also run certificated courses up to level 3 in Mindfulness and Wellbeing in Nature Practitioner.
